


Christian Writing: Timeliness in Writing

A. THE NEED TO BE TIMELY


1. While God's message are timeless, they are timely for some people *Isaiah 55¹¹*

- ✓ How do you maintain a burden?




B. THE MEANS TO TIMELINESS

1. Keep your axe sharpened


a) You need to be sensitive in your spirit *Jude 1³*

b) Your spirit is sensitive when under the influence of the Spirit. *1 Corinthians 2⁹⁻¹⁶*

c) The influence of the Spirit is encouraged by a healthy relationship with the word *Ezekiel 2^{1,2}, John 6⁶³*
